NOTES FROM THE NURSE

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The end of the school year is upon us. If your child has medication in the nurse's office, please plan to pick it up by **Friday, June 14th at 2pm**. Medication not picked up will be safely discarded.

At the start of each school year, a new updated doctor's order is required for any medication that will be administered during the school day. This includes daily medications, epipens, inhalers and any other medication that would be administered at school.

Completed forms must be on file with the nurse's office before medication can be administered.

Medication must be delivered to school by a parent/guardian in a labeled pharmacy container.

Below is a link to Billerica Public Schools medication policy, prescriber's order form, asthma action plan and allergy action plan.

A reminder that all students who will be in **Grade 3** for the 2024-2025 school year are required to have a current physical exam on file by **September 30, 2024**. You can either fax, scan to email or mail to Dutile Elementary School.
